

Half Way to Hāna Tour

Our first stop is the quaint old sugar mill town of Pā'ia with its wide variety of ethnic crafts, art, clothing, jewelry, and antique shops surrounded by sugar cane and pineapple fields.



Just a few minutes east, experience the world famous wind-surfing spot, Ho'okipa Beach Park. This breath-taking white sand beach that boasts some of the best waves on Maui.



Back on the road, we pass through the rural area of Haiku.

Here you may see banana patches, cane blowing in the wind, and/or forests of guava, avocados, papaya, and kukui nut trees.



Keanae is like stepping into the past.

Located on an old lava flow, it's graced by Keanae Congregational Church, built in 1860 of lava rocks and coral mortar. Keanae is famous for its traditional taro fields.

Upcountry Delight Tour

Travel up the leeward slopes of Haleakala to visit Ulupalakua, home of Maui's largest working cattle ranch. Stop at Maui's only winery, Tedeschi Vineyards. Learn about the different wines and indulge in some of their unique wine flavors in the Tasting Room.



When in bloom, the glorious jacaranda trees dot the pastoral landscape on the scenic drive through Kula, (on the way to historic Makawao) making it one of the most memorable views on Maui. Visit quaint Pā'ia town, known for its wide variety of art galleries and antique shops, on the way to the world-famous Ho'okipa Beach Park. Once you see the breath-taking surf, you will understand why wind-surfers from around the world flock here.



'Iao Valley is nothing less than mystical. Mark Twain called it "The Yosemite of the Pacific." The valley features the 'Iao Needle, a natural rock pinnacle presiding over the 'Iao Stream and surrounded by the walls of the Pu'u Kukui Crater.



Lovely Kepaniwai Heritage Park celebrates the varied cultures of the people that immigrated to Hawai'i to work in the sugar cane plantations.
